Modalizy wins Start Up Award

Modalizy has won first prize at the Best Start Up Awards 2018, at the #WeAreMobility salon in Brussels organised by Belgian automotive industry association Febiac.

The Award was presented by Belgium's Deputy Prime Minister Alexander De Croo, Flemish Finance, Budget and Energy minister Bart Tommelein, Febiac president Philippe Dehennin and Febiac CEO Luc Bontemps.

The Best Start Up Award includes €35,000 in prize money, which Modalizy will invest in the development of a MaaS platform and the rollout of a comprehensive solution for the management of mobility budgets.

It's the second major prize for the startup, now barely a year in business. In October last year, Modalizy already won the Link2Fleet Award.

A subsidiary of Belgian fuel and energy supplier Octa+ , Modalizy is a mobility platform with a single payment card for a multimodal range of services. It is aimed at companies that want to get a better overview of their employees' travel expenses - also to allow them better to recover VAT, by offering a single bill for various transport options.

Modalizy also offers an application that will tell users which is the best option of all available mobility solutions for the route they wish to follow.
